NewLife Radio Celebrates Its 25th Silver Anniversary!

WOW! 25 Years! On April 16, 1995, WMVV 90.7 FM signed on the air with its first broadcast. It was Easter Sunday and the vision and passion of Joe and Jenny Emert became a reality. *A lot has happened in 25 years!*

Broadcasting from a concrete building at the base of the broadcast tower, **NewLife Radio** began its commitment to air the best in Christian radio programming and music to listeners in Georgia. With a staff of one part-time person, **NewLife Radio** has become a staff of 10 full-time and part-time professionals. **A lot has happened in 25 years!**

Then in 1997 **NewLife Radio** applied for a second radio station license. After 10 years of delays, government red tape, and a lot of prayer, the FCC awarded 91.7 FM to **NewLife Radio**, and on May 10, 2010, WMVW 91.7 FM went on the air. **A lot has happened in 25 years!**

Missionary radio has always been a passion for this ministry. In 2000, Joe and a team of engineers were asked to assist in building the first Christian radio broadcasting network in Papua New Guinea (PNG). Over the next 10 years, **NewLife Radio** helped to build studios, install equipment, and train personnel to do programming, fundraising, and production. Now the PNG Christian Broadcasting Network is more then 32 radio stations strong and is self-supporting. **A lot has happened in 25 years!**

We have increased our community presence through our programming of local pastors and outreach at community events like the July 4th

Celebrations, the Conyers Cherry Blossom Festival and the Geranium Festival in McDonough. These events get us out into the


