

Text2Give is a service from the EFT Corporation, our secure credit card processing company, that makes it easy to give by simply texting an amount to our Text2Give phone number: 770-670-5771. Here's how to get started.

- **Register for Text2Give** by texting REGISTER to 770-670-5771. A link will be sent to you for you to register with your phone's browser.
- To give, simply text an amount (like \$100 or \$90.70) to the same number. The account you set up will be charged/debited within two business days. You will receive confirmation that your request has been accepted.



- You will receive a link in your donation confirmation which will allow you to designate all or some of your donation to a particular campaign or fund of your choice.
- **To update or remove** your registration, text UPDATE or REMOVE to the same number.
- **To cancel or have a payment partially refunded**, text REFUND or VOID to the same number. You will be contacted with confirmation and to clarify the amount to be refunded.

Tax Efficient Strategy for Sharing

For some of you there is a unique and beneficial way to give. Are you responsible for Required Minimum Distributions? RMDs, as they are so commonly named, often come at a time in life when you don't want them to. Your IRAs and 401ks can continue to grow tax deferred, but the government forces you to make a withdrawal once you reach age 72.

This forced distribution creates income for your tax return, and you guessed it, revenue for Uncle Sam. I've seen this excess income wreak havoc on tax returns. For some, it can make Social Security benefits taxable. Others may have to pay more for Medicare. There is a lot I could say on the negative effects of unwanted RMDs, but let's move on to a positive solution.

Now you can gift your RMD to charity. When you do, nobody pays tax on the money! You have to gift it straight to a 501c3 charity, like **NewLife Radio**. You will still get a 1099 to prove you took the RMD out of your account, but when you file the tax return it will not be counted as taxable income. You can gift up to \$100,000 per year. This one little "trick" not only prevents taxation on your retirement funds, it's also a great way to support the work of the ministry.
