

AUGUST



We met very soon after **NewLife Radio's** first radio station began broadcasting on April 16, 1995. Doug and Susan visited our spartan studios in Griffin and allowed me to share the dream of WMVV and how it could touch and bless many lives, sharing *Heartwarming and Life Changing* programming to Georgia, and beyond.

They became involved almost immediately and Susan became one of the first “cheerleaders” for this new Christian radio ministry. Wherever she went, just in casual conversation, she would share about her favorite radio station...and her Lord! Throughout the following 27 years Susan enthusiastically supported Doug in his growing involvement in the ministry of **NewLife Radio**, from volunteer announcer to advisory committee member, to board member, staff member, Director of Development, Assistant Manager, General Manager, Vice-President and finally, President.

I believe she may have attended more than 50 Sharathons, or other radio station events, to share her time and her love for people. She was a busy mother to Gregory and very involved at her church. She was right there beside Doug as they taught the college-age youth for many years. She was “Momma Susan” to many of those students!

We thank the Lord for the memory of Susan Doran. She is with the Lord now and made that last interstellar flight successfully earlier this year. I imagine Jesus laughing with her about one of her stories and can picture her telling Him about her favorite radio station. It is our prayer that another radio listener will step into the gap and become a cheerleader for **NewLife Radio!**

I liked popular music but I also grew up in church and GOD would not let me go. Your range of popular Christian music, from new contemporary to solid church hymns, helped anchor me as GOD was working in my life. I had been away from church for my latter teen years and early 20's.

I remember being excited when I “discovered” NLFM. I shared you with everyone! My connection goes much deeper though.

As an insurance agent at Farm Bureau I had the privilege of helping Jim Stewart (and family) experience a smooth transition while moving here.

For your 6-year anniversary, my wife (who owns a catering company), baked a NLFM anniversary cake and brought it to the station.

It was during that decade of time, that GOD not only brought me back to church but called me into the ministry! In the mid 2000's I shared a little of this story on the air as Joe and others were live on the square in McDonough at a festival.

I also had the honor of sitting with most of your staff at a table at Rocks Springs Church when Pastor John Hagee came to speak. It was a private pastor's meal but it really felt like I was sitting with my family. We were so excited about the new tower and station of 91.7—added range expansion. (My family and I moved to Fayetteville from Griffin about 2012!)

We are in Newnan now but two of our radio presets are still on the “Heart Warming, Life Changing” 90.7 / 91.7 FM **NewLife Radio**. You see, you never really know what kind of impact a new ministry will have. It's almost as if GOD created **NewLife Radio** as a helping hand to follow me for over 27 years now.
