
NewLife Radio's Jim Stewart to Retire on His 25th Anniversary

When WMVV first began broadcasting in 1995, the studios were in a concrete building at the base of a tower in Griffin. While a blessing, it was rough. No heat, no A/C during "on-air" times because of the noise, insects both large and small, and oh yes, no bathroom inside! So, why would Jim Stewart want to come work at **NewLife Radio**? It was a "calling!"

Jim received a BS in Engineering from LeTourneau University in Texas in 1977 and then worked on large ships as a welding inspector in Newport News, VA. In 1985, sensing God's call, he attended Regent University and received a MA in Communications which put him on the "road to radio." While in school, Jim worked at AM1010, WPMH.

In 1988, Jim joined the staff of Christian Radio WOLC in Princess Anne, in Monroe, LA, KLIC, AM1230. He and his wife, Glenna, were sent as Home Missionaries by the WOLC ministry. Jim was the owner, station manager, program director, and engineer. You could and should say, "he did it all." Once that ministry was established Jim turned it over to others as he began to sense God's direction elsewhere.

In 1997, Jim's son, James, was interested in becoming a student at Toccoa Falls Bible College in Northeast Georgia. The day they visited the college a "God Thing" happened! Joe Emert, founder of **NewLife Radio**, was prayerfully asking God to find the next staff member for the young ministry of WMVV. He contacted the Dean of Communications and Broadcasting at the college, asking if they knew of anyone who was interested in joining **NewLife Radio** full time. On the same day Jim spoke to the Dean wondering if he knew of any job openings. The contact was made to Joe Emert and Jim soon joined **NewLife Radio**. And as they say, "the rest is history." Yes! Isn't God's timing always perfect!

When Jim Stewart wanted to retire we began to search for our next Director of Operations and host of New Morning Praise. We posted ads on a number of broadcasting web sites and social media sites. Rob has an extensive resume that includes both local radio and network radio. His biography and testimony are also quite impressive. Here's just a short look at his career.

Shortly after becoming a Christian Rob began serving as a youth leader with his church. This led to a volunteer position with Student Venture, the high school outreach of Campus Crusade for Christ (now Cru). After graduating from The King's College in Briarcliff Manor, NY, Rob married his college sweetheart, Beth, and began seeking full-time work in youth ministry.


For the next three years Rob worked various jobs, sometimes stringing two and three part-time jobs together at a time just to make ends meet. Plans for full-time youth ministry and seminary were not coming to fruition. During this period of praying and searching he answered a newspaper ad for a Christian radio station in New Jersey. The interview led to a part-time role that eventually became a full-time career now spanning more than 25 years.

Rob, Beth, and their two adult daughters, Danielle and Emily, became part of **NewLife Radio** in October 2021. They moved nearly 2,000 miles from Arizona to Georgia, and are looking forward to the life of ministry and service the Lord as prepared for them.
