first met Pawa Warena on my initial trip to Papua New Guinea (PNG) in 2001. I had been asked to visit that South Pacific Island country to explore the possibility of submitting a governmental license to construct that country's first nationwide Christian broadcasting network. An exploratory committee had already been established in the country. Almost all of the committee members were exclusively Papua New Guineans. And, as an expression of their strong faith, they had already quietly started the process of raising funds

for such a project!

Pawa was a man of strong Christian character and solid faith. He was a born leader and had been raised in the Highlands of PNG where he lived on a mission station operated by Evangelical Bible Missions. As a child he assisted the missionary and his teacher, Miss Lenita Bustin, with many daily duties. Pawa grew, thrived, learned exceptional English, attended Nurses Training, and became a licensed nurse. As he matured in his faith and work, he was asked to become the country's official health department's liaison to public and private hospitals and health clinics across the nation of 5 million people.

But, Pawa had a vision! He was "sold-out" to his vision of seeing Christian radio used across his country to bring spiritual health to his people. Soon after "Wantok Radio Light" was launched in 2002, he began broadcasting to the nation. Pawa sensed God's leading to resign his very good and secure government job and accept the position of Managing Director of **Wantok Radio Light**. His years of management, planning, working on budgets, and organizing complex events equipped Pawa in a wonderful way.

As part of his continuing education and "baptism" into Christian radio, Pawa visited the United States to tour several Christian stations and networks. The trip, largely funded by **NewLife Radio**, made it possible for Pawa and his team to connect with

numerous resource centers to assist the fledgling radio network back home. We rented a van and hit the road, visiting Christian radio stations and ministries in Georgia, Pennsylvania, Ohio, Indiana, and Illinois. Pawa then returned to Papua New Guinea

invigorated and energized!

Under his leadership the **Wantok Radio Light** ministry of grew. Starting with a single FM radio station located in the capitol city of Port Moresby, the ministry soon added a short wave station covering the entire country. Additional FM radio stations were added over the years. Now, under the capable leadership of others and an active board of directors, the PNG Christian Broadcasting Network has grown to more than 26 FM stations. It is truly a miracle story of God's grace giving birth to a valuable ministry. It has brought spiritual healing and health to thousands of radio listeners.

At **NewLife Radio**, we thank God for the exemplary life of faith and vision of Pawa Warena. Now present with the Lord, he is among that "great cloud of witnesses" cheering us on to accomplish great exploits for Christ and to run with perseverance the race marked out for us! Truly, may Pawa's tribe increase in the Kingdom of God.
